#### From the Dean's Desk...

#### Fellow Alumni,

I am happy to report that we are finally seeing some light at the end of the tunnel regarding the pandemic. The numbers of COVID-19 cases in the community are dropping along with our inpatient numbers. The School of Nursing continues offering in-person classes with COVID-19 screenings, masks, and social distancing practices.

The pandemic continues to impact our enrollment numbers. I still believe people are fearful to enter our profession after hearing the news stories about the stress that this pandemic has had on our fellow nurses locally and across the country. We remain hopeful that the new scholarship will increase interest in our beloved profession and assist students to achieve their goal of becoming registered nurses. This scholarship/loan program will cover students' tuition and fee costs (after any scholarships and grants) resulting in a full-time RN position within Trinity Health System. To date, 12 students/graduates have taken advantage of this opportunity. The nursing shortage is very real and it is impacting every hospital nationwide.

On July 16, 2021 we honored 18 new graduates. The pandemic did impact the way in which they received information. Unfortunately, not all of the graduates successfully passed the NCLEX-RN Exam. Although our pass rate dropped to 83.3%, Trinity continues to exceed State and National pass rates.

The School of Nursing used CARES Act monies to enhance our Skills Lab with simulation and other progressive learning tools. We have seven simulators including a pregnant/delivering mother, baby, and child. This technology is amazing! Our students now take their unit exams online via ExamSoft on laptops purchased with CARES Act dollars.

The Faculty is working diligently to prepare students for the Next Generation NCLEX (NGN) exam. The National Council of State Boards of Nursing (NCSBN) plans to change the format of the licensure exam in 2023. The rationale for this change is to, "help nurses think critically when providing care and make the right decisions".

We are thankful for the two Alumni Scholarships that were awarded last year. The Faculty, Staff, and Students of the School of Nursing are grateful for the support of the Alumni Association. I hope to see more of you at our April meeting!






