# From the Dean's Desk...

## Greetings Fellow Alumni,

As if you already didn't know this, but you are graduates of one of the Best Nursing Programs in the State! Out of 123 Nursing Programs in the State of Ohio, Trinity Health System School of Nursing is one of two programs to achieve a 100% pass rate on the NCLEX-RN in 2022. We are the only local pro- gram to receive this rating. Pass rates across the nation have declined over the past five years. The 2022 national s rate was 79.9% with Ohio's rate being 75.83%. The School of Nursing has achieved a 100% pass rate four out of the past six years and has consistently exceeded state and national pass rates.

We continue to request that our Fellow Alumni promote our beloved profession and alma mater in an effort to help attract individuals to Nursing as a career. The nursing shortage continues to impact Trinity Health System plus most hospitals nationwide. The need to recruit individuals to Nursing has never been greater.

On July 14, 2023 we will have 16 new graduates join our 2,466 Alumni. This group of graduates will be the first to take the Next Generation NCLEX (NGN) exam. According to the National Council of State Boards of Nursing (NCSBN), "the NGN exam uses case studies like you would see in the real world to reflect the kinds of critical decisions nurses have to make in a variety of healthcare settings. It focuses on interactions between nurse and client, the client's needs, and expected outcomes." I don't know about you, but it sounds like the types of questions that I answered on many exams taken at this very School of Nursing. The faculty have been working diligently to prepare the current group of graduates for this new test- ing format.

The long awaited new units on the Trinity West Campus will open this summer. Our students will be able to provide quality nursing care on state of art nursing units. We hope that the majority of the new graduates will stay with Trinity to care for the patients in our Community.




